To discuss future plans.	<p>Organisation:</p> <p>Font Communications, acting for KGSP, will provide secretarial support for the LLG and chair the initial meeting. A Chair, elected by LLG members, will chair all subsequent meetings, unless the Group decide to continue with the initial chair for subsequent meetings.</p> <p>Meetings will not be open to members of the general public and the venue will be a community location close to the site (e.g. Byley Village Hall) or online via Teams if preferred by a majority of members or future COVID-19 lockdowns prevent face-to-face meetings.</p> <p>Meetings will be held on a quarterly basis.</p> <p>Minutes will be circulated to all members within twenty working days of the meeting.</p> <p>All documentation in relation to the LLG will be available to download from the KSGP website.</p>
